The listed members and suspected members of the La Cosa Nostra (LCN), Baltimore Division, only FRANK CORBI and JOSEPH GIGLIOTTI have any indication of being engaged in any illegal activities during the past several years. CORONA, MORICI, and ANELLO are in poor physical health and their movements are restricted by their afflictions and old age. JOSEPH CORBI operates a pizza business which is owned by himself and FRANK CORBI, and he is not known to engage in any illegal activities. JOE TAMBURELLO, proprietor of a small neighborhood grocery store, devotes most of his time to operating this business. CHARLES BARBERA and JAMES ROMANO, both barbers, show no sign of any illegal activity, but spend most of their time at their businesses.
