Informant related this game will again be managed by PHIL GENOVESE and SALVATORE TARTAGLIA aka "Sammy The Wop". NY 5042-C-TE advised he knew of no interstate aspect to this game.

On the same date the above information was furnished to Deputy Commissioner JOHN WALSH, NYCPD.
