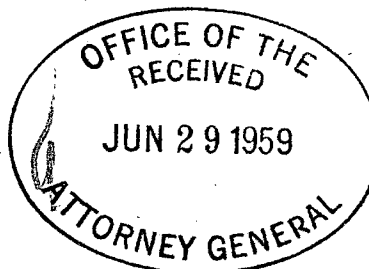

Dear Mr. Attorney General:

The Federal Bureau of Investigation has furnished to us a large number of reports reflecting interviews by FBI Agents of defendants and co-conspirators in the Apalachin case.

The material furnished is of the greatest value. Several of the reports, for example, summarize interviews taken just a few days after the Apalachin meeting and bear out clearly the pattern of falsehood which is in the heart of the conspiracy charged.

Much of the material furnished will certainly be affirmative evidence in support of the Government's case; a good portion of the balance will be most useful for purposes of cross-examination and otherwise. All of the material reflects the FBI's uniformly excellent investigative techniques.

I thought you should be informed of the important contribution that the Federal Bureau of Investigation is making to the success of the Apalachin case.
