Enclosed for the Bureau are xerox copies of two memos which are self-explanatory.

TROY ADAMS, District Director, and PATRICK DUVALL, Inspector, Immigration and Naturalization Service, New Orleans, La., advised that they will prepare a deportation case against ANTONIO PANZI, aka, TONY PANZI. INS officials advised that PANZI is illegally in the United States and that his true name is ANTHONY MESSINA. INS advised that MESSINA committed a murder many years ago in Sicily and subsequently fled to France where he committed a double murder, according to information developed by INS, MESSINA is a Mafia "hit man."

INS located the real TONY PANZI in Sicily and determined that years ago he was a neighbor and friend of MESSINA. INS primary difficulty is in proving that PANZI is MESSINA. During World War II fingerprint records in France concerning MESSINA were destroyed.

INS officials requested any information and Bureau files which would tend to identify PANZI as MESSINA.

For the information of the Bureau, PANZI is NO 1284-PC, Bureau file 137-13261. No 92 case has been yet opened on PANZI until final determination as to whether or not he will convert to a TE.

A review of New Orleans files reflect two memos, copies of which are enclosed, which could be construed as evidentiary matter by INS. Bureau is requested to review these two memos together with PANZI's PC file and determine whether or not New Orleans should make available to INS copies of these two memos.
