AS RESULT OF CONTINUED FBI INVESTIGATION OF LCN BURGLARY RING HEADED BY LCN MEMBER JOHN SACCO AND FOLLOWING OUR RAID OF DECEMBER FIVE LAST IN WHICH OVER ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS OF STOLEN FURS WERE RECOVERED AN ADDITIONAL TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OF STOLEN PROPERTY RECOVERED TODAY IN RAID BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES ON RESIDENCE OF STEPHEN GIARDINA, THREE ONE FIVE AUBURN STREET, BUFFALO, N.Y.. RECOVERED ITEMS INCLUDED STOLEN SILVERWARE, FURS, CIGARETTES AND ANTIQUES.. GIARDINA IS CLOSE ASSOCIATE OF SACCO AND A BUFFALO CITY EMPLOYEE.

ON NIGHT OF NOVEMBER SIXTEEN-SEVENTEEN LAST EXCLUSIVE PITT-PETRIE STORE BUFFALO BURGLARIZED AND FIFTYTWO THOUSAND DOLLARS OF SILVERWARE STOLEN.

MYTEL OF TWELVE FIVE LAST REPORTED INVOLVEMENT OF SAME INDIVIDUALS IN THEFT AND RECEIVING OF OVER ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS OF STOLEN FURS WHICH WERE RECOVERED IN RAID THAT DATE BY BUAGENTS AND LOCAL POLICE.

TOP ECHELON INFORMANT BU THREE ZERO FIVE - C - TE HAS MAINTAINED CONTINUOUS DAILY CONTACT WITH SACCO AND INFORMANT ADVISED THAT AS RESULT OF RAID IN WHICH FURS RECOVERED AND FEAR OF DISCOVERY SACCO AND ASSOCIATES CONSOLIDATED NUMEROUS STOLEN ITEMS IN THEIR POSSESSION AT THREE ONE FIVE AUBURN STREET LOCATION.

FISUR BY BUAGENTS ON TWELVE TWELVE LAST SHOWED SACCO AND TRUCK GOING TO ABOVE ADDRESS. TRUCK DETERMINED TO HAVE BEEN RENTED UNDER ASSUMED NAME PROBABLY BY SACCO.

SINCE NO APPARENT FEDERAL VIOLATION INVOLVED INFORMATION DISSEMINATED TO NYSP AND BUFFALO PD. BASED ON ABOVE STATE POLICE OBTAINED SEARCH WARRANT FOR AUBURN STREET RESIDENCE.

IN RAID TODAY OBSERVED BY BUAGENTS, POLICE RECOVERED LOOT FROM AT LEAST SIX LOCAL MAJOR BURGLARIES, INCLUDING A FULL LENGTH CHINCHILLA FUR COAT VALUED AT TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ANTIQUES STOLEN FROM GABRIEL CARDELL. CARDELL IS AN ASSOCIATE OF DE CICCO AND SUSPECT IN THE DUPONT ROBBERY. NO ARRESTS MADE SINCE GIARDINA OUT OF TOWN.
