Enclosed herewith for the Bureau are six copies of an LHM concerning SILVIO CARMELO PERRETТА, setting out his connection with members of the Detroit LCN family.

On 12/20/67, DE 1049-C-TE advised that SILVIO PERRETТА, former business partner of LCN boss ANTHONY ZERILLI, had been sent to Sicily by Detroit LCN bosses to do a particular job. Source said he did not know specifically what PERRETТА's assignment was, but he did know it was "a very distasteful job". He also said that by carrying out this assignment PERRETТА was supposed to be able to "discharge an obligation" which he had to the Detroit LCN family. Source indicated that PERRETТА was very bitter prior to his leaving the United States.

Detroit files indicate PERRETТА was subject of an Anti-Racketeering investigation, Defile 92-1507, Bufile 92-9431, which was closed 12/66. This file indicates PERRETТА has made several trips between Italy and the U.S. in the past several years and shows that he was a business partner with ANTHONY ZERILLI in Silvio's Spaghetti Palace, 31653 Gratiot Avenue, Roseville, Michigan.

On 5/26/67, DE 889-C-TE advised that SILVIO PERRETТА was doing extremely well in his new restaurant business on Gratiot Avenue.

On 6/19/67, the same source advised that PERRETТА's partner, TONY ZERILLI, had very suddenly dissolved his partnership with PERRETТА for no apparent reason.

On 7/31/67, DE 1110-C advised that SILVIO PERRETTA was returning to Italy where he intended to stay permanently.

On 8/25/67, the same source advised that SILVIO PERRETTA had received a very severe physical beating from the Detroit mafia boys prior to his leaving Detroit for Italy.

During interview with PERRETTA 6/15/67, he advised SA PAUL EDWARD EIDEN he was no longer connected with TONY ZERILLI in the restaurant business and that he was planning to return to Italy because of poor health.

It is requested that the enclosed LHM be furnished the Legat in Rome with the request that appropriate inquiries be made to establish that SILVIO PERRETTA is, in fact, in Italy and further, to make any appropriate inquiries in an effort to substantiate information furnished in LHM.
