the United States to be that of uniting "all of the exile organizations to fight against the tyranny imposed by FIDEL CASTRO. We will not unite ourselves with bandits because revolutions are not made with bandits. Neither will we accept those who have their hands stained with gold or with blood."

Above article stated that CONTE AGUERO was accompanied by Commander PEDRO LUIS DIAZ LANZ and the two anti-CASTRO leaders disclosed that the exile groups will join soon in a secret place in Miami for the purpose of choosing "the person who will guide the destinies of the country."

It is noted that "El Diario de Nueva York," a New York City Spanish language daily newspaper, July 6, 1960, page 6, contained a column by BABBY QUINTERO concerning DIAZ LANZ which identified DIAZ LANZ as the leader of a group called Cruzada Cubana Constitucional (Constitutional Cuban Crusade - CCC).

On July 5, 1960, MM T-2, an American businessman who formerly had business contacts with highly placed Cuban Government officials, advised that approximately two weeks prior to the above date he had been in contact in Washington, D. C., with PEDRO LUIS OSCAR DIAZ LANZ, whom he described as the former Chief of the Cuban Air Forces under FIDEL CASTRO. According to the informant, DIAZ LANZ told him he was in town with a couple of other people. DIAZ LANZ did not divulge to the informant the exact nature of his business in Washington, D.C., the identity of the people he was with or the identity of anyone he contacted in Washington, D. C.

DIAZ LANZ accompanied the informant to dinner on this occasion, and during dinner advised the informant that he was experiencing severe financial hardships. DIAZ LANZ sought the informant's assistance in obtaining employment in the Washington, D. C., area.
