Enclosed are nine copies to the Bureau and one to Miami of a letterhead memo and evaluation memo dated and captioned as above.

The information in enclosed letterhead memo was furnished by [WFO 1161]S to SA DONALD HOETING on 8/29/61. (c)

For information of the Bureau and Miami, [WFO 1161]S [C] learned the information in enclosed letterhead memo from ERNESTO BETANCOURT, who visited MANOLO RAY in Washington, D. C. during the evening of 8/23/61. [C]

During BETANCOURT's conversation with RAY, RAY also volunteered information that he had spent a number of hours in conference with ARTURO MORALES - CARRION, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for ~~Latin~~ American Affairs, during the day of 8/23/61. CARRION had advised RAY to forget all the Cuban exiles and anti-Castro groups in the U. S. and return to Puerto Rico and wait until contacted by a representative of the U. S. Government. [C]

It is noted that CIA advised the Bureau that on 6/21/61, all dealings with Cuban exile organizations were to be handled not by CIA, but through the Office of ARTURO MORALES - CARRION. [C]
