Enclosed herewith are 11 copies of a Letterhead Memorandum, dated and captioned as above, as well as 11 copies of an evaluation memorandum.

Information contained herein was received from MARIANO ROCA-GUTIERREZ, a Cuban exile living in Puerto Rico who is under development as a PSI on Cuban matters. ROCA is not a member of any particular anti-CASTRO exile group, but is friendly to all these type groups in Puerto Rico. He is a personal friend of Dr. MIRO CARDONA, President of the Consejo Revolucionario. (S)(u)

ROCA was in Chicago, Illinois on a business trip during the week of 2/4-9/62. On his return trip to San Juan, he stopped off at Miami, Florida, where he visited Dr. MIRO CARDONA. ROCA noted that Dr. MIRO CARDONA is worried by the reported influence and friendship MANOLO RAY of the MRP enjoys with Governor LUIS MUNOZ MARIN of Puerto Rico. ROCA states that this concern arises from the fact that there is a divisional split within the MRP, whose exile leaders are in Miami, but which is reportedly controlled from within Cuba. (S)(u)

ROCA advised that MANOLO RAY appears to have ready access to Governor MUNOZ MARIN and is often seen entering and leaving La Fortaleza, the governor's mansion in San Juan. (S)(u)

ROCA stated that it is his opinion, gathered from other Cuban exiles, that MANOLO RAY wants the MRP to stress socialistic ideas in its political platform with which the MRP leaders in Miami and Cuba are not in agreement. It is (S)(u)
