Attached five copies of letterhead memorandum sets forth information received from NY 2305-C on 2/1/62.

In addition, informant advised that at a New Jersey meeting on 1/23/62 HOFFA became extremely embarrassed by the activities of ANTHONY PROVENZANO. PROVENZANO requested HOFFA to speak before a meeting of 1,000 Communications Union Workers who desired an IBT charter. Prior to his speech HOFFA discovered these individuals were members of the IBEW and HOFFA felt he could not offer them a charter because of his friendship with GORDON M. FREEMAN, International President of IBEW. He was extremely bitter with PROVENZANO because he had confused the identity of the local union involved. Informant stated HOFFA did make the speech and promised the workers an IBT charter, although he has no intention of carrying out this promise.

Informant advised he is friendly with N. Y. State Senate Speaker JOSEPH CARLINO and had been approached this week by Assemblyman MARK LANE, who made the conflict of interest charges involving CARLINO in Lancer Industries, a bomb shelter building concern. LANE asked the informant to contact CARLINO on his behalf since he has been "ostracized" by members of the New York Assembly since making the charges. Informant contacted
