Reference Mexico City letter to the Bureau 1/22/71 captioned as above and also under caption of "Cuban Aviation Company (CAC)".

Since submission of referenced letter, material which ROJAS has told (to MEX 197) has been reported in the CAC file (Bufile 105-89660) and the FPM - Mexico file (Bufile 109-12-210).

Concerning ROJAS as an individual, MEX 197 reported that ROJAS has had some problems with his superiors at the CAC offices in Mexico City and is dissatisfied with his job. On 4/14/71 MEX 197 advised that ROJAS has been asked to go to Cuba because of what he calls a very complicated and disagreeable problem and which he is unwilling to discuss. It apparently involves his sister-in-law TERESA PROENZA. He remarked his wife CARIDAD PROENZA DE ROJAS had a problem getting a visa the last time she went to Cuba and it was only by getting a message to CELIA SANCHEZ, FIDEL CASTRO's secretary, that the visa was issued.

MEX 197 noted that he has offered ROJAS a commission on the sale of three Comet IV-C jet airliners owned by the Mexican Aviation Company if CAC buys them. Source applied for a Cuban visa on 4/19/71 and ROJAS invited the source to accompany him and his wife since they are planning to go to Cuba in mid-May.

On 4/21/71 MEX 197 advised he saw ROJAS the previous day. The subject said that the situation in Cuba is very bad but declined to elaborate. He said he is now reluctant to have his wife accompany him but, if worse came to worse, they

would both be "forced" to go. ROJAS then said it might be better if MEX 197 were to travel separately since by going together he might "create a problem for himself." (u)

(u) MEX 197 advised he has been unable, to date, to get to the bottom of ROJAS' current problem. He added that the subject's son, JOSE LUIS ROJAS PROENZA, aka Max, has become a near hermit. He only needs to submit his thesis to obtain his Ph.D. degree but will not do so even though he has ghost written thesis for fellow students who have received their degrees as a result.

(u) Mexico City will follow the subject's situation through MEX 197 being alert for any development which might be capitalized upon.
