SAMUEL M. GIANCANA, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY.

CG 6533-C ADVISED SIGN AFFIXED TO ARMORY LOUNGE TODAY, FOREST PARK, ILLINOIS, HEADQUARTERS OF GIANCANA AND HOODLUM HANGOUT, REFLECTING THAT ESTABLISHMENT OFFICIALLY CLOSED UNTIL APRIL 24. INFORMANT LEARNED THAT CLOSING CAUSED BY ILLNESS OF OWNER CARMEN FANNELI, WHO HAS ENTERED HOSPITAL FOR OPERATION. (u)

CG 6486-C* DISCLOSED DOMINIC "DUTCH" BLASI, BODYGUARD AND CHAUFFEUR FOR GIANCANA, AND TARQUIN "QUEENIE" SIMONELLI, BROTHER-IN-LAW OF TONY ACCARDO, IN LENGTHY DISCUSSION WHILE CONDUCTING SOME TYPE MANUAL LABOR AT ARMORY LOUNGE YESTERDAY. BLASI MADE PHONE CALL FROM LOUNGE AND REPRIMANDED UNKNOWN PERSON FOR NOT MEETING HIM AT AN OFFICE TUESDAY LAST. BLASI AND SIMONELLI DISCUSSED ACQUISITION OF NEW TELEPHONE FOR LOUNGE AND BLASI TOLD OF WARNING GIANCANA FOR USING TELEPHONE EXCEPT TO ARRANGE MEETING DATES. BLASI MENTIONED THAT HE WILL DELIVER QUANTITY OF "LEADS" (POSSIBLY REFERRING TO TELEPHONE APPARATUS) TO JOHN KRINGAS. KRINGAS IS OWNER OF GUS'S STEAK HOUSE, NOTORIOUS CICERO, ILLINOIS GAMBLING ESTABLISHMENT. (u)
