A pro-CASTRO group of approximately 45 men and women picketed south side of Latreen 15th and 16th Streets from 12:30 P.M. until approximately 3:30 P.M.

At 1:30 P.M. five busloads of anti-CASTRO persons believed to be pro-TRUJILLO persons arrived vicinity Statler Hotel. These persons numbered approximately 250 and were permitted to picket south side of K Street between 16th and 17th Streets. Numerous police officers in vicinity and picketing carried on in orderly fashion. At \$3:45 P.M. the 250 pickets boarded buses and travelled to 16th and Florida Avenue, not being allowed closer to the Cuban Embassy than the junction of these streets. CASTRO returned Cuban Embassy 4:50 P.M. ( )

Above activities observed by SAs HAROLD RUBENSTEIN and GERARD C. CARROLL, who also observed that JACK KIEFFER, son of Colonel JOHN E. KIEFFER, former registered agent of BATISTA, was present during picketing Statler Hotel. Also present were MM 639-S, I. IRVING DAVIDSON. PAFAEL del PINO, PEDRO de MESONES and MANUEL

Captain MICHAEL J. MAHANEY, MPD, advised on evening 4/16/59 that because of DAVIDSON's overbearing attitude concerning pickets he, MAHANEY, had very sternly made both DAVIDSON and MESONES aware of the fact that the MPD would handle the picket lines and that if either of these persons interfered, stern action would be taken on 4/17/59 MAHANEY advised that CASTRO would visit Vice President NIXON 7:00 P.M. Sunday at the Capital rather than at NIXUN's home.

PSICIORGE PERRAMON Y SPENCER advised SA DONALD HOETING on 4/17/59 obswation concerning CASTRO and anti-CASTRO groups was noval and no incidents had occurred. PSI will attend banquet at Cuhan Embassy evening of 4/17/59 and keep WFO advised (W) W

PSI ENRIQUE PACHECO COLMENARES advised SA RUBERT C. BYRNES 4/17/59 meeting for night of 4/16/59 of ORTH-CASTRO group concelled because ANIVAL DELGADO, former BATISTA intelligence officer at Cuban Embassy, felt things were neon hoen with CASTRO in town and meeting would be held after CASTRO's departure. MM 639-S on 4/16 and 17/59 advised SA RICHARD B. KELLOGG that DAVIDSON has been attempting to recruit informant to obtain information for DAVIDSON, which information to be sold to Nicaraguan Government. Informant could furnish no information concerning planned incidents regarding CASTRO (%) (U)

With regard to DEL PINO, PSI COLMENARES has advised that DEL PINO has received instructions to cause no incidents while in Washington, D. C., or elsewhere concerning CASTRO, since it will upset the plans of the group, consisting of General TABERNILLA, Jr., etal.

For the information of the Bureau, all data pertaining to security of CASTRO has been furnished to the MPD, Park Police and Fairfax County Police Department immediately upon receipt. As mentioned in WFO airtel 4/15/59, two MPD detectives are riding with State Department representative and all information furnished to MPD by WFO is verbally furnished to State Department representative on street with MPD.

WFO will submit data of interest to other agencies in form suitable for dissemination and will keep Bureau advised on current basis.
