PUJOL WANTS INFORMANT IMMEDIATELY OBTAIN FOUR P FIFTYONES, TWO VAMPIRE JET PLANES, ONE TRANSPORT CAPABLE CARRYING FIFTY MEN, TWENTYFOUR MACHINE GUNS, AMMUNITION AND BOMBS FOR THE PLANES AND THIS ARMAMENT IMMEDIATELY INSTALLED. P FIFTYONES AND JETS HAVE TO BE READY TO LEAVE MIAMI IN FIFTEEN OR TWENTY DAYS. PUJOL HAS ADEQUATE MONEY TO PAY CASH FOR PLANES AND GUNS AND INTENDS LEASE AIRPORT TO MAKE NECESSARY INSTALLATIONS AND LOADING OF PLANES FROM US TO UNKNOWN DESTINATION. EXPEDITION TO CONSIST UNKNOWN NUMBER MEN FROM GUATEMALA, NICARAGUA, MIAMI AND A THOUSAND FROM DOMINICAN REPUBLIC. EXPEDITION WILL INVADE CUBA FROM DIFFERENT COASTAL AREAS. NO MOUNTAIN WARFARE WILL BE FOUGHT. EXPEDITION WILL HAVE AID FROM ANTI CASTRO GROUPS IN CUBA SUCH AS DEJECTED JULY TWENTYSIX MEMBERS AND OTHER UNIDENTIFIED GROUPS. INFORMANT IS CONTACTING I. IRVING DAVIDSON TO OBTAIN NECESSARY MACHINE GUNS. INFORMANT UNABLE OBTAIN ADDITIONAL DETAILS AT THIS TIME, BUT HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED MAKE EVERY EFFORT OBTAIN COMPLETE FACTS. CUSTOMS BEING ADVISED. BUREAU WILL BE KEPT ADVISED OF ALL DEVELOPMENTS.
