Reurtel 5-20-59 captioned "Anti-Fidel Castro Activities" which advised that MM 639-S was contacting Davidson to obtain machine guns.

On 5-25-59 Davidson contacted the Bureau. He advised that Howard Davis, who had been working with Rafael del Pino, called him last week and told him he needed twenty-four .50 caliber machine guns. Davidson asked Davis to write a letter and he would, thereafter, contact Munitions Control for authority and obtain the guns. Davis, however, did not want any part of this. Davidson thought Davis was headed for a "crack-up."

Immediately submit your comments concerning this data, particularly any information indicating that informant is headed for a "crack-up."
