Re Bureau letter to Miami 4/16/63, with CIA enclosure TDCSDB #3/654,014 dated April 3, 1963. (S)(X)(u)

Re CIA report states that a torpedo type device was being prepared by Cuban nationals with a remote controlled type apparatus, and the device was being readied at 7531 S.W. 14th Street, Miami, wad was described as a 4x6' cylindrical gun shaped device. (S)(X)(u)

On April 17, 1963 it was ascertained there is no such address in Miami, Florida.

On April 18, 1963, Mr. WALLACE SHANLEY, U. S. Customs Agent, Miami, advised he had received a copy of referenced CIA report, and immediately recognized it was "garbled information" and pertaining to information previously reported in Miami airtel of April 4, 1963, with enclosure entitled "PEDRO LUIS DIAZ LANZ: NEUTRALITY ACT - CUBA," Bureau file 105-72630.

In this letterhead memorandum MM 635-S reported that DIAZ LANZ' associates include MM 635-S, and they were in the process of constructing a 5'x3' boat from plywood and fibreglass, in the backyard of a residence at 7331 S.W. 16th Street, Miami. It was intended to use this boat as a homemade torpedo containing 500 pounds of C-4 explosive, which would be created and detonated. (S)(X)(u)
