During contact set out in enclosed LHM, DIAZ LANZ furnished an eight-page leaflet captioned "Major Diaz And the Press". This leaflet, a reprint of an "American Opinion" article, sets out alleged press distortions of testimony given by DIAZ LANZ before the Senate Internal Security subcommittee in July, 1959, following his defection from Cuba. He also furnished a paperback copy of "Its Very Simple", subcaptioned "The True Story of Civil Rights". This 1965 book by ALAN STANG seeks to substantiate the author's charge that "the Civil Rights Movement is for the most part a Communist operation under the cloak of which the Communists hope to capture this country". DIAZ LANZ also furnished a one page Spanish language handout warning Cuban exiles not to participate in a "Replica"-sponsored street protest on behalf of ORLANDO BOSCH and other arrested Cuban Power members. The handout asserted that this public activity, like Negro street demonstrations in various cities, was initiated by Communists in the hope of provoking violence between marchers and civil authorities. The handout was signed "PEDRO LUIS DIAZ LANZ". DIAZ LANZ indicated that he has ideas for more such handouts and owns a duplicating machine, but lacks paper and does not presently have the funds to purchase same.

The above-mentioned paperback is a newsstand item and has no significance in this matter. It is therefore not being maintained. The eight-page leaflet and one page handout are being maintained in the 1-A section of the MM 105-1598 file.

DIAZ LANZ during contact set out in enclosed LHM, gave no indication that he is deranged or emotionally unstable; however, as DIAZ LANZ has renewed his right wing lectures and has shown himself eager to participate
