

Subjects in this case were involved in unsuccessful anti-Castro plot to blow up ship in Mexico in April, 1967. Based on information we developed, Mexican authorities located explosives which had been buried in Mexico by some of those involved prior to their return to United States.

Investigation is being conducted at specific request of Department which has indicated there are possible violations of Title 18, Section 956 (Conspiracy to injure property of a foreign government) and Title 22, Section 1934 (Unlicensed exportation of munitions).
