Re Bureau letter to Mr. J. WALTER YEAGLEY, Assistant Attorney General, dated 8-14-67.

On 8-24-67, FERNANDO GUTIERREZ BARRIOS, Director, Direccion Federal de Seguridad (DFS - Federal Security Police) (PROTECT IDENTITY), advised that to his knowledge the Mexican Army has conducted no further examination of the explosive materials recovered in Mexico which had been buried by the Subject. (9)

He stated that for such analysis to be made, the request would have to be made through official diplomatic channels by the United States Government directly to the Mexican Government. (9)

Reference is made to our previous communications in the captioned matter particularly to your communication dated June 20, 1967, and to our communication dated August 7, 1967, with enclosure.

Your June 20, 1967, communication requested that a determination be made as to whether the explosives recovered in this matter appear on the Munitions Control List. Our August 7, 1967, communication transmitted a Mexican Army report which described the explosives which had been recovered. *(W)*

Attached is a copy of a memorandum dated August 10, 1967, at Washington, D. C., which indicates that an official of the Office of Munitions Control advised that additional descriptive data or chemical analysis is necessary in order to make a determination as to whether the explosives are on the Munitions Control List. *(W)*

We are endeavoring to obtain additional information concerning the explosives. If additional data is obtained, it will be referred to the Office of Munitions Control so that a determination can be made. *(W)*

○ Endeavor to obtain additional descriptive data or chemical analysis of the explosive material so that further contact can be had with the Office of Munitions Control. Submit any additional pertinent data in this regard in form suitable for dissemination. (S)(u)

NOTE:

Subjects in this case were involved in unsuccessful anti-Castro plot to blow up ship in Mexico in April, 1967. Based on information we developed, Mexican authorities located explosives which had been buried in Mexico by some of those involved prior to their return to United States. (S)(u)

Investigation is being conducted at specific request of Department which has indicated there are possible violations of Title 18, Section 956 (Conspiracy to injure property of a foreign government) and Title 22, Section 1934 (Unlicensed exportation of munitions).
