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MM T-3 said that DIAZ blamed JORGE GARCIA GRANADOS, personal advisor to President YDIGORAS, and the Communists for his expulsion from Guatemala. According to DIAZ, the purpose of his trip was to move anti-CASTRO operations out of the United States, utilizing the sympathy of other Latin Americans to foster support to take the pressure off of the United States in the eyes of Latin America. ~~(S)~~ (u)

MM T-3 remarked that DIAZ said that while in Guatemala, he spoke with (FNU) GONZALEZ SIGUI, Minister of the Interior, and high-ranking officers of the Guatemalan Army who appeared to be sympathetic toward the anti-CASTRO cause. ~~(S)~~ (u)

On March 25, 1960, JOSEPH THURMAN, Investigator, Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Miami, made available the file of that office under number A-11881130, relating to the subject which set forth information that the subject departed the United States from New Orleans, Louisiana, on December 29, 1959, via Pan American World Airways, flight 503, with the stated purpose of obtaining a visa for permanent residence in the United States.

This file also revealed that on March 15, 1960, subject filed an Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission Into the United States After Deportation or Removal at the American Embassy in Mexico City, D. F., which was denied by the District Director of INS, Miami, on the basis that it did not merit the exercise of favorable discretion.
