SA ROBERT JAMES DWYER conducted the interview and
states it is a custom among Cubans to serve to visitors
received at their homes or offices small demitasse cups of
black, strong, bitter Cuban coffee. SA DWYER cannot recall
if he was offered coffee or not but he doubts he drank it
inasmuch as he does not like Cuban coffee.

ZARRAGA has not been checked, contacted or
interviewed by Miami Office since 1/25/63.
