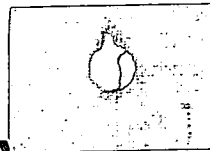

SAMUEL M. GIANCANA, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6486-C* ADVISED ON JANUARY 20 LAST THAT A PARTY WAS HELD AT THE ARMORY LOUNGE, ATTENDED BY JOHN MATTASSA, DOMINIC BLASI, EDDIE LNU AND OTHERS UNNAMED. CG 6502-C* ADVISED JANUARY 20 LAST THAT GUS ALEX AND BUTCH LADON DISCUSSED A PARTY TO BE HELD THAT NIGHT "AT CARMIES PLACE," ATTENDED BY THEM AND EDDIE VOGEL. THIS WOULD BE THE ARMORY LOUNGE, OWNED BY CARMEN FANELLI. THIS PARTY WAS A MIXED AFFAIR WITH MALES AND FEMALES PRESENT. NOTHING OF PERTINENCE NOTED, EXCEPT THAT GIANCANA WAS DEFINITELY NOT PRESENT. NO INDICATION AS OF THIS DATE THAT GIANCANA HAS RETURNED TO THE CHICAGO AREA. HE HAS NOT BEEN IN VICINITY OF THE SOURCE SINCE JANUARY 13 LAST. CG 6457-PC ADVISED RECENTLY THAT GIANCANA SPENT AN EVENING AT THE D'ORS CLUB, FORMERLY THE KEY LOUNGE, OPERATED BY ROCCO PRANNO, ON JANUARY 5 OR 6 LAST, BUT HAS NOT BEEN OBSERVED FOR SEVERAL WEEKS. ARMED AND DANGEROUS. (u)
