Re Newark letter to Bureau dated 11/30/64.

NK 2381-C-TE advised SA WALTER L. BARKER on 12/7/64, that he met with CARL PALO during past week and asked him what happened to the alleged fix in the TONY PROVERANO case.

C

PALO replied that it was the fault of Attorney HENRY G. SINGER who represented TONY PRO. SINGER was supposed to ask for a postponement due to the fact that "their judge" would not be on the bench. This judge was off attending a college affair involving his son who was becoming a lawyer. The nature of the affair is unknown. According to PALO, SINGER would not listen to "them" and went ahead anyway.

Informant does not completely trust PALO. He believes PALO will lie to accomplish his own advantage whenever necessary and he further described PALO as a person who likes to "gild the lily".

Informant is not a regular or close associate of PALO and has formed this opinion of him as a result of about six contacts. It appears obvious that attorney SINGER did not trust this information of PALO's either.
