Newark PCI advised SA NORBERT R. M.J. LINKER on May 29, 1963, and May 31, 1963, that he has made inquiry among his associates concerning the WALTER GLOCKNER murder.

His associates are of the opinion that the most popular metive among the gambling element is that WALTER GLOCKNER was a shylock and that he possibly was murdered as a result of having refused to heed and follow orders to stop infringing on shylock territories heretofore controlled by other shylock operations.

PCI further states that another theory is that GLOCKNER was murdered because he was a member of an insurgent group in Local 560, IBT, and could possibly have furnished damaging testimony in the extortion trial involving ANTHONY PROVENZANO, also known as Tony Pro.

The PCI states that GLOCKNER allegedly had a shylock operation with ROBERT GWINNETT. This operation reportedly centered in Hoboken. The PCI stated that ROBERT GWINNETT and WILLIAM P. BRYAN reportedly received letters and/or phone calls shortly after the GLOCKNER murder in which the, were warned that they would be the next victims.

PCI indicated that he was making further inquiry into the alleged shylock operation of GLOCKNER and his associates.

PCI stated that GLOCKNER and GWINNETT frequent the Club Jaguar, 111 Monroe Street, Hoboken, New Jersey, which formerly was known as the Satellite Bar.

PCI stated that it appears to be common knowledge among the gambling element in Hoboken that <u>UBALDO SANDA CROCE</u>, also known as <u>Cisco</u>, had reportedly been living in <u>Florida</u> for the past two years. He allegedly returned to Hoboken, <u>New Jersey</u>, sometime prior to the <u>GLOCKNER</u> murder for no apparent reason. PCI stated that CISCO reportedly left town sometime after the <u>GLOCKNER</u> murder.

In elaborating on the alleged shylocking involving GLOCKNER, PCI stated that JOHN O'SHEA, who is the owner of O'Shea's Bar in Hoboken, New Jersey, was known to be shylocking money in Hoboken. O'Shea's Bar located at 404 Newark Street in Hoboken is used as a meeting place for many of the members of Local 560, IBT, and a "shape-up" is located for Local 560 adjacent to O'Shea's Bar.

PCI advised that GLOCKNER possibly may have been infringing upon O'SHEA's territory in regard to shylocking.
