It is pointed out to the Bureau that in January 1963, NY 3864-C-TE (deceased, member source) advised that the Apalachin meeting was a continuation of a meeting held earlier at RICHIE's farm (RICHARD BOIARDO) wherein an explanation was offered re the necessity for slaying ALBERT ANASTASIA. Some of the leaders present were identified as VITO GENOVESE, TOMMY LUCHESE, JOE RICCOBONO, JOE BIONDO, TOMMY RAVA and numerous others. Further, that the Apalachin meeting was subsequently set up to advise the national hoodlum groups inasmuch as only metropolitan LCN members attended the N.J. meeting.
