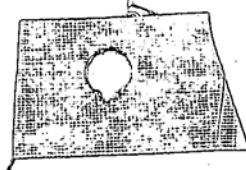

DAILY SUMMARY. PCI [ ] REPORTED OCTOBER 1 LAST REGARDING HIS RECENT TRIP TO PHOENIX, ARIZONA WITH SAM ENGLISH AND MIKE SABATINO, BOTH GIANCANA LIEUTENANTS. INFORMANT ARRIVED PHOENIX SEPTEMBER 26 LAST, MET AT AIRPORT BY JOSEPH ENGLISH, BROTHER OF SAM, DROVE 93 MILES EAST TO A RANCH NEAR RIMROCK, DRIVING ON BACK ROADS. ENGLISH POINTED OUT 400 ACRES OF RANCH TO BE SUBDIVIDED, THEN DROVE TO HOME ON RANCH LOCATED ON TOP OF A HILL; WHERE SEVERAL LOOKOUTS WERE POSTED. INFORMANT COUNTED NINE UNIDENTIFIED INDIVIDUALS STAYING AT RANCH HOME WHO ARE APPARENTLY, IN WORDS OF INFORMANT, HIDING OUT. ENGLISH POINTED OUT SOME DRY WELLS IN AREA, TOLD INFORMANT " THIS IS WHERE WE DROP BOYS WHO DONT BEHAVE". PARTY DROVE BACK TOWARD PHOENIX REGISTERED AT SAFARI MOTEL, FROM WHERE ENGLISH CALLED JOSEPH AMATO, FORMER CHICAGO HOODLUM, NOW RESIDING IN TUSCON, ARIZONA. ENGLISH ADVISED INFORMANT HE OWNS PROPERTY NEXT TO AMATO IN TUSCON.
