The following information was recently received by the Department of Justice from a confidential source who has furnished reliable information in the past:

A conference of various persons including James R. Hoffa, two vice presidents of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, and Joseph F. Verhelle, former president of Public Bank, Detroit, allegedly took place in Hoffa's office in Washington, D.C., on or about November 18, 1963. They discussed matters concerning the Teamsters Pension Fund, allegedly including the possibility of a loan from the fund for the purpose of purchasing the building at 130 North Franklin, Chicago, Illinois. Meissner Engineers, Inc. (MEI), formerly occupied the top five floors of this building and now is reportedly interested in purchasing the building, possibly in conjunction with Verhelle and/or other purchasers.

Verhelle reportedly felt that the above-mentioned loan could be made and that Robert C. Meissner, president of MEI, could be of assistance to Hoffa in view of business and political contacts of MEI in Nashville, Tennessee, and Chicago. Verhelle indicated he had received information that MEI had done work on a chemical plant in Tennessee about a year ago and also had contacts with the Tennessee Highway Department and various other agencies and political figures in Tennessee. Verhelle also conveyed the impression that Federal Judge Richard Austin of Chicago is an old friend

of the family. To further explore the possibility						
that might be utilized for the benefit of Hoffa in						
connection with the cases pending in Federal courts in						
Nashville and Chicago, Verhelle indicated that he would soon						
confer with an attorney who was not identified by name but						
who was referred to as the "quarterback" of the team of more						
than 30 attorneys who reportedly are working on these cases						
for Hoffa. Verhelle anticipated that after so conferring,						
it would be determined whether might be able to						
help Hoffa through efforts directed toward one or more members						
of a jury or toward the judge himself.						
Washalla allocally Committee to the state of						
Verhelle allegedly favored trying to make an						
"arrangement" with Judge Austin through on the basis						
of being an "old friend", and it was Verhelle's feeling that						
if Judge Austin were to make some rather minor procedural

be of great value to Hoffa. Verhelle indicated that in
