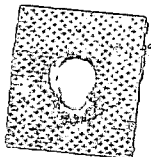

A confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on November 28, 1966, that Francois (Last Name Unknown) consulted Ducarnel Bocage, First Secretary, Embassy of Haiti, Washington, D.C., advising that (S) "someone" (not further identified) at telephone number DI 7-3400 has information concerning a possible invasion of Haiti which is to occur in about ten days.

It is noted that the District of Columbia edition of the Washington Metropolitan Area Telephone Directory, as corrected through August 3, 1966, and published by the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company, Washington, D.C., lists telephone number DI 7-3400 to the office of I. Irving Davidson, 1612 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

On November 28, 1966, Mrs. Ulde Poland, Registration Section, Internal Security Division, United States Department of Justice, advised a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that I. Irving Davidson, 1612 K Street, N.W., is a Washington, D.C., public relations man who is registered as an agent of the Government of Haiti, among others.

It is further noted that the "Diplomatic List," dated (u) (S) August, 1966, [a United States Department of State] publication, lists Ducarnel Bocage as First Secretary, Embassy of Haiti, (S) Washington, D.C. (S) (u)
