I. Irving Davidson, Public Relations
and self-admitted Registered Agent at the United States
Department of Justice, Washington, D.C., for Haiti furnished
the following information on March 11, 1970.

[Fritz Dominique] a member of the staff of [Haitian
Ambassador to the Organization of American States Fern
Baguidy] advised Davidson that Marie Denise Dominique, wife (S)
of Max Dominique, Haitian Ambassador to France, and the son-
in-law and daughter respectively of Haitian President for
life Francois Duvalier, will be coming through Washington,
D.C., on Sunday, March 15, 1970, en route to Haiti.

Denise Dominique will be accompanied by her sister,
Simone. They are returning to Haiti to celebrate their
mother's birthday in March, 1970. [Fritz] additionally (S)
indicated that Max Dominique would follow the above visit
towards the end of March, 1970, and would also visit
briefly [with Fritz Dominique] in Washington, D.C. (S)

Davidson further indicated it is known to [Fritz
Dominique] that Duvalier and Max Dominique appear to have (S)
reconciled their former personal differences, because
Duvalier frequently converses with Max Dominique in Paris,
France.

Davidson stated that [Haitian Ambassador to the
United States, Arthur Bonhomme] appears to have had a most (S)
unsatisfactory trip to Haiti in the recent past. Davidson

explained that [Bonhomme] is not returning routine telephonic requests to get together for luncheon to exchange views on [Bonhomme's] trip. Davidson stated he had no hard information to establish in fact that [Bonhomme's] trip was unsatisfactory. It is an impression he has formed due to [Bonhomme's] obvious choice to avoid Davidson. [Bonhomme] has used these previous post [Duvalier] visit luncheons to extol his genius in dealing with the problems of Haiti and his personal dedication to [Duvalier] in solving them.

Davidson stated there is continuing concern on the part of the Haitian Government and the image projected in various United States informational media. Davidson made reference to the March, 1970 edition of "True Magazine" which Davidson describes as "bad mouthing" Haitian President Duvalier and the Haitian people. Davidson stated he intends to hold discussions with appropriate officials of the United States Government to counter the views expressed in the above mentioned publication which Davidson stated were base and false. Davidson felt that its author, a Mr. Andrew St. George, was the same individual who sold the Columbia Broadcasting Company a packaged show on Haiti which was deliberately falsified and which the Columbia Broadcasting Company subsequently had cause to regret.
