Over the past years, I have enjoyed a close, personal friendship with Major General Elie Zeira, Defense Attache of the Israel Embassy. General Zeira is leaving his position in Washington and returning to Israel, where he will replace General Aaron Yariv, Director of Military Intelligence for the Government of Israel. (General Yariv was Military Attache in Washington in 1959, and I am also privileged to have his close friendship.)
