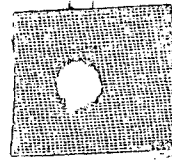
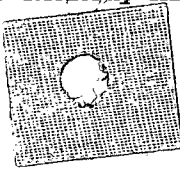

Re New York letter and letterhead memorandum dated 2/12/60.

The indices of the Mexico City Office reflect that Chicago letter dated 7/10/46 entitled "JAMES WEINBERG, was., ET AL, TFIS" (Bufile 15-16161) made mention of one DOROTHY BALDWIN of the Stauffer System, 219 North Michigan Avenue, Chicago. This DOROTHY BALDWIN had advised one PAUL ROLAND JONES on one occasion that he could contact her husband at the Laboratory in Los Angeles. According to this letter, no information had been obtained as to the identity of DOROTHY BALDWIN's husband and it is not known if this DOROTHY BALDWIN could be identical with captioned subject.

The indices of the Mexico City Office had no other reference to captioned subject's name and aliases.

On 3/9/60 *[MEX-18 and MEX-19]* (protect identity), who have furnished reliable information in the past and who are well-acquainted with the activities of the American Communist Group in Mexico (ACGM) were alerted by SA GEORGE F. MUNRO to captioned subject's possible presence in Mexico. *(S)(u)*

On 3/23/60 *[MEX-118]* (protect identity), who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished SA FREDERICK E. RODERICK a written report dated 3/10/60 which is contained in *[MC 134-325A-473]* *(S)(u)*

This report reflects that the records of the Office of Classification, the general records and the National Registry of Foreigners of Mexican Immigration under the Secretary of the Mexican Ministry of Government, Mexico, D. F., were negative for any record on captioned subject's name and aliases.

This report reflects ~~██████████~~ MEX-118, who is well-acquainted with the Mexican immigration rules and laws, furnished the opinion that the subject possibly entered Mexico as a tourist and with this status no record would be available on the subject at Mexican Immigration, Mexico, D. F. (X)(u)

MEX-118 advised that in order that an adequate check be made on the subject's entrance into Mexico as a tourist the port and date of entry, the mode of travel and the exact name would be necessary. (X)(u)

On 3/24/60, the records of the Citizenship Unit, U.S. Embassy, Mexico, D. F., were negative for the subject's name and aliases.

On 3/24/60 [MEX-18] and [MEX-19] advised SA GEORGE F. (X) MUNRO that no information had come to their attention concerning subject's presence in Mexico. Other Mexican sources, such as [MEX-1] and [MEX-46], have been alerted to the subject's (X) possible presence in Mexico. (X)(u)

No dissemination is being made of the above data inasmuch as it is all negative with regard to the subject possibly being in Mexico. (X)(u)
