Sapp, Intelligence Unit, Miami Police Department, who has been in contact with the Dominican Consulate, Miami, on numerous occasions and has furnished information to the Miami Office concerning criminal intelligence and top hoodlum matters.

Altagracia G. de Fox, former Auxiliary Consul, Dominican Consulate, Miami, (PSI), stated on 3/6/62 that subject had for years been the liaison contact between the Miami Police Department and Dominican Consulate. On one occasion subject and other police officers took a trip to the Dominican Republic as guests of the Dominican Republic.

SAPP, Miami Police Department, Intelligence Unit, had for years been the person contacted by the DR Consulate in matters requiring liaison between the DR Consulate and Miami Police authorities. She stated that on one occasion some time ago, exact date not recalled, SAPP, with other police officers, was invited to take a trip to the DR as guest of the DR and he did She stated that SAPP never acted as an agent of the DR or received any money for anything which he did as far as known. analyst for Ex DR leader RAFAEL L. TRUJILLO MOLINA 1956 - 60, claimed to MM 768-C that SAPP had for years sold information to the Dominican Government and the files in the DR should show this.

It is noted that JOHNSON has been interviewed on two occasions as a result of his claims to knowledge of the Dominican Intelligence operation. On both occasions when specifically questioned he claimed to have no specific knowledge.

Miami files further reflect that on October 12, 1958, EDUARDO HERNANDEZ, then Cuban Consul in Miami, advised SA ROBERT J. DWYER in connection with the investigation of the case entitled SERGIO SANJENIS CABARROCAS, aka; ET AL, Bufile 2-1505, that Detective CHARLES SAPP of the Miami Police Department, had informed him of the arrest of HUGO GONZALEZ LAJONCHERE, one of the individuals involved, and furnished HERNANDEZ with a police report on the matter.

It is noted that the above case referred to the attempted formation of a demolition team to operate against the then Cuban Government which HERNANDEZ then represented in Miami.

Miami files reflect that SAPP has in the past furnished information in connection with criminal intelligence matters to the Miami Office and at the present time he is furnishing information to the Miami Office in connection with the hoodlum program.
