## INFORMANTS:

On March 17, 1969, LV 121-C-TE advised SA CARL F. FREEMAN that NORMAN ROTHMAN of Miami, Florida, was presently in Las Vegas, Nevada, and was observed in a meeting at the Caesars Palace Hotel-Casino with owners and key executives there. Subsequent investigation reflected that ROTHMAN was presently staying in room 686 at the Sands Hotel-Casino in Ins Vegas, arriving March 14, 1969. This information was disseminated to Lieutenant GENE CLARK, Intelligence Unit, Clark County Sheriff's Office (CCSO), in Las Vegas, on March 17, 1969.

On the evening of March 17, 1969, Special Agents JAMES E. DOYLE and MICHAEL G. SIMON were in contact with the following officers of the CCSO at the LITTLE-HAYWARD Junior Middleweight Title Fight:

Sergeant CHARLES MARTIN Sergeant KARL ALBRIGHT Sergeant CURTIS LACKIE Detective PHILIP LEONE

The title fight was held at the Las Vegas Convention Center.

SA DOYLE identified NORMAN ROTHMAN to Sergeant MARTIN. Subsequent observations reflected that NORMAN ROTHMAN was sitting at ringside seats in the company of PARE PRICE, a Las Vegas daily newspaper columnist, GASPARE A. SPECIALE, a bookmaker and shylock who is presently under investigation of his Extortionate Credit Transactions activities in Las Vegas and Samuel Filippo Manarite, who is presently under similar investigation, by Las Vegas. At the conclusion of the main event, ROTHMAN, accompanied by SPECIALE and MANARITE, left the convention area where the fight was held and were subsequently placed under arrest by the Clark County Sheriff's Office Intelligence Unit, each on the charge of Vagrancy-Loitering.

As MANARITE was leaving the convention area, he was observed by SAs DOYLE and SIMON to have spoken briefly to
