The source stated that BORIS OREKHOV, a KGB Officer, assigned to the NY Residency, had had two meetings with LANE and had established a trusted relationship with him. [NY 5812-S\*] (s) stated that subject had subsequently travelled to Europe but had not been contacted since his return to the US. (S)

[NY 5812-S\*] stated that the NY Residency of the KGB (s) had established "conditions" of meetings with LANE. (S)

As a matter of information, BORIS M. OREKHOV, a Soviet national, was employed as the information officer, Office of Public Information, at the UN Secretariat, NYC. He last departed the US on 4/2/66. (S) (u)
