1. CURRENT COUNTERINTELLIGENCE ACTIVITY

American Committee for a True
Marxist-Leninist CP (ACTMLCP) NY

The Bureau has authorized the mailing of Progressive Labor literature to 3 CP members in Seattle who were somewhat upset over receipt of the letter they received from the ACTMLCP concerning the new CP youth organization. They thought the letter came from Progressive Labor. The NYO intended to send the July issue of "Progressive Labor" but as of this writing, this issue is not yet out. If it appears the July issue is going to be included in the August issue, then a copy of "Challenge", the weekly Progressive Labor news letter, will be sent to the Seattle subjects.

The ACTMLCP received a letter from GILBERT STEINER, instructor of mathematics at Reed College in Portland, Ore., asking for more information about the ACTMLCP. STEINER gave his new address in Canada to which he wanted the information sent. A similar letter from an SWP member in Seattle was received but neither letter was answered.

CP Activity in
Leonia, New Jersey

Two agents assigned to the NYO who live in Leonia, New Jersey, have become aware of a large group of people in Leonia who have Communist backgrounds and have been hindering the paper functioning of the Leonia Board of Education. This information was furnished to the Newark Office for possible use under the Counterintelligence Program.
