Buring the latter part of February, 1962, members of the 30th of November Movement, an anti-Castro organisation, met in Miami, Florida, with Theodore Raccosin, who was understood to be President of the International Broadcasting Company, New York City, and with William Willnum, who was understood to be head of Redio Free Europe, believing that they might be able to assist the Bovement in obtaining United States Covernment backing. DECLASSIFY ON: On June 22, 1962, arrangements were mede for Recoosin and Villiam Baggs, Editor of the "Miami Daily Mows," to get in touch with each other. Recoosin subsequently errived in Mani, indicating that White House representatives had contacted him and had saked him to go to Mismi to contact Baggs, whom he described as President Kennedy's representative. [Recossin stated that the White House doubted that the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) was giving the true picture of Cuban matters and Indicated that White House investigation of CIA operations was being conducted in Mismi by Daggs. Recoosin was interested in contacting anti-Castro individuals, particularly those who had previously participated in CIA operations and in having then made available to Baggs for interview. 23/U
