Reference is made to discussions held on November 8 and November 9, 1962, between Mr. Victor John Wallen and Mr. Sam J. Papich of this Bureau concerning the handling of Cuban double agent operations in the Miami area.

As pointed out by Mr. Papich, this Bureau does not feel that it is obligated to keep your Agency apprised of all pertinent developments in cases such as illustrated by the activity of Odio. We will make available to you all pertinent information developed which may have a bearing on your interests. This could include leads and data which could be of assistance to you in your programs directed against the present Cuban Government.

This Bureau wishes to confirm the position taken by Mr. Papich; namely, that CIA operation of Cuban agents in this country would constitute an infringement of FBI jurisdiction. As you know, there has been a long-established understanding with your Agency to keep us apprised of information coming to your attention concerning agents who might be operating in the United States.
