Memorandum Mannall to Sullivan 4-9-68 outlined changes in assignments of Supervisors in this Section. The memorandum pointed out that additional recommendations would be made as to filling a vacancy in the Southeast European Unit when the situation had further crystallized.

The increased work on the Yugoslav Desk in the Southeast European Unit has made it necessary to relieve the Supervisor-in-Charge, W.F.A. Callahan, of his assignments relating to the handling of East-West Exchange matters and temporary visitors from Hungary. This work has been assigned to the desk formerly occupied by SA R.R. French and Albanian matters have been transferred from that desk to Supervisor L. F. Schurza.

SA J.P. Thomas has been relieved of handling all Yugoslav matters with the exception of those relating to the Yugoslav Embassy and the special Yugoslav cases in New York tied in with the operation of Confidential Informant W-1373-9. This has resulted in increasing the assignment on the second Yugoslav Desk in the Unit which is handled by SA R.C. Fleustor. SA Callahan will devote more time to the handling of the special problems arising in the cases on U.S. Government employees who are utilized as sources by the Yugoslav Intelligence Service. (S)

SA R.R. French, who on 4-8-68 was assigned temporary duty in the Cuban Unit, has now returned to his desk assignment in the Southeast European Unit. This, of course, has resulted in the loss of one Supervisor on the Cuban work which is still abnormally heavy. The return to duty of SA F.L. Jones would alleviate this situation; however, he underwent major surgery on 4-24-68 at Bethesda Hospital and faces the possibility of further extensive surgery. Accordingly, by separate memorandum a temporary replacement for SA Jones is being requested.
