Dr. ERNESTO ARAGON GODOY, 233 East 69th St., NYC,  
Delegate of the Consejo Revolucionario de Cuba (CRC),  
advised on 10/10/62 that he had returned from Washington,  
D.C. on 10/6/62 where he had been with Dr. JOSE NINO  
CARDONA from 9/22/62.

Dr. ARAGON advised that the purpose of Dr.  
NINO's visit to Washington was to confer with representatives  
of various Latin American Delegations in Washington prior  
to the meeting of Foreign Ministers which took place in  
Washington on 10/2 and 10/3/62. Dr. ARAGON stated that  
Dr. NINO CARDONA met with and discussed the problems of  
Cuba with many of the delegations and also prepared a  
statement which was read at one of the conferences of  
Foreign Ministers which was held on 10/2/62.

ARAGON advised that in general it could be stated  
that the results of the Latin American Foreign Ministers  
meeting was very encouraging as far as the Cuban exiles  
cause was concerned and that the recommendations made  
were more than expected but not as much as the Cuban exiles  
desired. ARAGON stated that with the exception of the  
Delegates from Mexico, Brazil, Chile and Ecuador, all  
the Latin American countries were in favor of taking a  
very strong position against Cuba and were willing to go  
so far as to take military action against the CASTRO government.
