Re New York letter to the Bureau dated 11/6/62.

Dr. ERNESTO ARAGON y GODOY, 233 East 69th Street, New York City, Delegate of the Consejo Revolucionario de Cuba (CRC), advised on 12/3/62, that he had been to Washington, D.C. from 11/26/62 until 12/1/62, relative to work pertaining to the CRC. ARAGON advised that he was leaving New York on the morning of 12/4/62 for Chicago, Illinois, where he would meet Dr. MIRO CARDONA and they would then proceed by plane to Minneapolis, Minnesota, where Dr. MIRO CARDONA had a speaking engagement and was to attend a dinner. ARAGON advised that they were going to telephonically contact Attorney General ROBERT F. KENNEDY on 12/6/62 to ascertain whether he wanted Dr. MIRO CARDONA to come to Washington from Minneapolis or to proceed directly to Miami, Florida. ARAGON advised that he expected to be back in New York City on the weekend of December 8, 1962.
