The following information is being submitted
to the Bureau, Miami, and WFO for their information and
guidance in matters pertaining to anti-PIDEL CASTRO activities.
This information will not be submitted in form suitable
for dissemination since the contents of this letter reflect
the interests of the US Department of State and also the
interests of the Central Intelligence Agency, (CIA).

Doctor ERNESTO ARAGON-GODOY, 233 East 69th
St., NYC, Secretary to Doctor JOSE MIRO CARDONA, President
of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, was interviewed on
3/7/62, relative to his recent trip to Washington, D.C.
where he, MIRO CARDONA, and Doctor MANUEL ANTONIO DE VARONA
met with officials of the US Government and discussed matters
pertaining to Cuba and anti-CASTRO activities. ARAGON
advised meetings were held at the US Department of State
on 2/27 and 28/62, and again on 3/3/62.

The account of the meetings in Washington, D.C.
as furnished by Doctor ARAGON is as follows:

ARAGON advised that he arrived in Washington, D.C.
at 9:30 p.m. on 2/26/62, and immediately proceeded to the
Raleigh Hotel where shortly thereafter he met Doctor MIRO
CARDONA and Doctor DE VARONA who had arrived from Miami,
Florida. ARAGON said that CARLOS PIAD, representative
of the Revolutionary Council in Washington, D.C., and VARONA
insisted that VARONA accompany MIRO CARDONA to the talks
in Washington, D.C., and reluctantly MIRO CARDONA agreed.
