Special Agent TOM MEYER (PROTECT IDENTITY), confidentially advised that Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Company records reflected that telephone BR. 7-3528, assigned to RICHARD A. RANLES, 3352 Atlas Street, San Diego, had been discontinued on 2-1-82. Notes on telephone account reflected that Mrs. RANLES had gone to Kansas City about 1-20-62 and correspondence for RICHARD RANLES was to be forwarded to DOMALD RANLES, 101 "I" Street, Chule Vista, California.

Ers. RUDGLPH FECHO, 9391 Atlas Street, Ban Diego, (BB 7-0365) advised she was bandling the rental of the residence at 3352 Atlas Street. She also stated that Br. and Brs. RAHLPS had a disagreement and Brs. RAHLPS left alone for Kapsas City about two and a half weeks ago. She attempted to take the children with her but was prevented from doing so by Br. RAHLPS. The latter is residing with relatives in Chula Vista, California, name and address unknown, and apparently has the children with him.

The Bureau is being kept advised of pertinent information developed by NC 737-C+ through tri-weekly Airtels as weakly summaries submitted under the Criminal Intelligence Program. All information furnished by this source is being incorporated into the substantive case file in this division.

All offices which might utilize information reflected in this report should use extreme care and discretion in order to conceal the source so that its value will not be compromised.

In addition, certain information has been developed through CG 6486-CP and EC 737-CP concerning possible ownership of the Monte Carlo Club and a race track at Las Vegas, Novada. In both instances, a Mrs. JOSEPH BEOWN has a financial association with the locations and a separate lead has been set forth under the title "CHIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM - KANSAS CITY DIVISION" for the Las Vegas Division, as well as the St. Louis, New Orleans and Cleveland offices, to conduct certain investigation in relation to the ownership of these locations. This matter will not be dealt with in detail in this report but in view of the fact that it involves not only subject but other Kansas City hoodlum figures and until pertinent information pertaining directly to CIVELLA is developed, this information will not be reported in detail in the CIVELLA reports; however, copies of all investigative activity are being channelized to the substantive case file.
