Pertinent information regarding Top Hoodlum figures in the Kansas City Division has been submitted under separate communications on a continuing basis.

Resirtel reflected FMLIX FERINA had surrendered to the U.S. Harshal to begin serving a ten-year prison sentence for conspiring to kill a Government narcotics informer, KENNETH BRUCE SHEETZ. The reason for this is not known to date, however, Capt. JOHN J. FLAVIN, Chief of Detectives, Kansas City, Mo. Police Department, advises that sources known to him have stated that higher-ups in the criminal organization in Kansas City have become displeased by FERINA's failures in unsuccessfully executing individuals such as SHEETZ. It is his belief that FERINA voluntarily entered the USP to keep from being eliminated by others of the Italian criminal element.

CARL ANGELO DE LUMA, FBI #4121933, was reportedly the individual to succeed FERINA as the executioner for the crininal element in Kamsas City. Other authorities, both local and Federal, have no information concerning this matter.

NICHOLAS CIVILLA, AND THOMAS AND CHARLES CACIOPPO had conference at Original Toy and Jobbing Co. CACIOPPOS accused CIVILLA of "not liking" them and passing unfavorable information concerning them, which CIVILLA denied. CIVILLA stated THOMAS's troubles stemmed from his gambling losses and other activities. The CACIOPPO brothers had apparently visited an individual in Chicago who refused to speak to them. CIVILLA stated that in all his contacts throughout the country he had emphasized the fact that he should always be contacted by telephone or otherwise prior to any visit to assure him it was a legitimate visit, and not an informer or the FBI.
