the Subject's residence at approximately 2:40 p.m. It was determined that this plate is registered to KATARINA WENESCH, 27653 Wagner Street, Warren, Michigan.

On May 8, 1963, Corporal CLEM HILL, Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Windsor Ontario, telephonically advised that 1963 Ontario License Plate Number 811-362 is registered to Maroon Brothers, 808 Gladstone Street, Windsor, on a 1961 Oldsmobile hardtop. HILL stated that the Maroon Brothers also run a fruit and vegetable department at 233 East Chatham Street. He advised that there were three brothers who owned the market and their names are FREDERICK, JOHN and JOSEPH. He knew of no criminal activities on the part of any of these individuals.

It was noted that the above car was observed parked by the Sheik Cafe in Downtown Detroit a couple months ago when the Subject's car was also observed in that vicinity.
