Enclosed is the original and four copies of a LHM setting forth information requested by the Department of Justice.

One copy is also enclosed for the NKO for information.

On 3/23/64, NY 3610-C advised that ZICARELLI was in Florida during the past week and is expected home either today or tomorrow. In fact, ZICARELLI, according to the informant, will meet JOE NOTARO on 3/24/64 probably in NYC.

Informant also advised that ZICARELLI met CHARLIE TOURINE while in Florida probably on Thursday, 3/19/64. Informant was told this by TOURINE when he called the informant from Miami on 3/20/64. Further it was ZICARELLI who furnished TOURINE with the informant's telephone number. This information should be reported with discretion since the identity of the source can be easily determined.

The first confidential source mentioned in enclosed LHM is NY 4003-C-TE, contacted by SA JAMES M. MC ANDREW, and the second source is NY 4010-C* (Anonymous source), familiar with material in possession of Attorney STEPHEN L. HOFFMAN, 855 Sixth Ave., NYC.
