PROPOSED VISIT OF FOUR BUSSIANS TO THE UNITED STATES, SUMMER 1958

On 5/12/58, Confidential Informant PH 27-S, who has furnished reliable information in the past, made available to SA MARION B. HUMMEL the 4/26/58 issue of the "Friends Journal, a Quaker weekly, published by the Friends Publishing Corporation, Philadelphia, Pa.

Page 271 of this issue contains an uncapationed article indicating that "Young Friends" have made final plans for a sixweek summer visit of four Russians to the United States pending Soviet confirmation of their invitation. The article states that the Committee of Soviet Youth Organizations and various Soviet Embassy people have expressed great interest in this visit.

The article indicates that six Americans will travel with the Russians by automobile, and that New York, Philadelphia, Washington, D. C., High Point, N. C., the Tennessee Valley Authority, Richmond, Ind., Chicago, and Des Moines are probable stopping places on the tour. Plans include contact with Friends; visits to industry, farms, and schools; as well as visits to areas of public interest to the Soviet young people. that no large public meetings are contemplated.
