Referenced airtel set forth lead for Miami to locate and interview DAVID QUINTA concerning an allegation that QUINTA, 48 Northwest 7th or 8th Street, Miami, was connected with a plan to recruit men and organize an expedition to leave for Cuba.

A review of Miami indices reflected QUINTA is probably identical with one DAVID QUINTAS. MM 639-S furnished information regarding DAVID QUINTAS in 8/62 and 9/62, indicating QUINTAS was in contact with an American adventurer named GERALD PATRICK HEMMING in connection with proposed expeditions to Cuba. QUINTAS allegedly had made statements to the effect that he could obtain ten German 7.62 mm rifles from the National Gun Shop in Miami. He claimed he could obtain some arms from the Guatemalan Government, providing he could arrange for the transportation of these arms, and as of 9/7/62, he was considering traveling with HEMMING to Illinois in connection with the purchase of arms.

To date, efforts to locate QUINTAS have been negative. The address 48 Northwest 7th Street is a factory, and QUINTAS was not known there. The address 48 Northwest 8th Street is a restaurant belonging to the Imperial Hotel,

45 Northwest 8th Street. Inquiry at the Imperial Hotel failed to develop any indication that QUINTAS is or had been residing there.

The records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Miami, Florida, do not contain any record which could be determined identical with QUINTAS on the basis of available background information.

MM 639-S has been requested to obtain information regarding the present whereabouts of QUINTAS, and he will be promptly interviewed upon receipt of results of this inquiry. X(U)
