NOTE TO SACs, NEW YORK, MIAMI AND WFO, CONTINUED:

y Godoy, Secretary to Jose Miro Cardona, will endeavor to obtain any concrete information he may have concerning this matter. Submit letterhead memorandum under this caption. Since this item appeared in the press, there should be no difficulty encountered by Agents of your office in discussing this matter with Aragon.

NOTE:

National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) called attention to item appearing in press indicating that Jose Miro Cardona, head of Cuban Revolutionary Council, in discussing arms shipments being sent to Cuba by the Soviet Union, indicated that these arms would interfere with U. S. missile launchings. NASA requested any information which would have bearing on the validity of this information. Aragon has been most cooperative with our New York Office in furnishing us details of the activities of Cardona, including his visits to the Attorney General and other Government officials. It is probable that he would know something of this matter, and it is believed we should avail ourselves of the opportunity to talk to him about it.

Subject : Electronic equipment allegedly being installed  
in Cuba

1. The Washington Post, September 6, 1962, carried an article datelined Miami, Florida, September 6, 1962, which is quoted as follows:

"The Cuban Revolutionary Council said last night that arms shipments being sent into Cuba by the Soviet Union would be used to interfere with United States missile launchings. Jose Miro Cardona, president of the Cuban exile group, said in a statement: 'In different sections of Cuba, principally in the north coast of the province of Pinar del Rio, missile rocket bases and electronic equipment are being installed for warlike operations.' Mr. Cardona said the equipment would be used by the Fidel Castro regime to 'detect and interfere with the launchings from Cape Canaveral in Florida.'"

2. It would be appreciated if you would furnish any information in your possession concerning the validity of the information appearing in paragraph 1 of this memorandum. It would be helpful to know the type of electronic equipment being installed in order to determine if such equipment is capable of interfering with launchings through introduction of false signals or nullification of intended signals.

3. Similar requests have been directed to the Departments of the Army and Air Force, and the Central Intelligence Agency.
