On 9/24/62, [WF 1376-S\*] furnished the following information: (S)

On that date one Dr. (fnu) LORA (phonetic) of the "International Bank" contacted [the Embassy of Costa Rica] and advised that he was calling at the request of Dr. JOSE MIRO CARDONA to advise that MIRO was out of town on an interview and, therefore, had to break his appointment with [Ambassador GONZALO FACIO]. (S)

The informant continued that a few moments later one Dr. (fnu) ARAGON of the Cuban Revolutionary Council contacted [Costa Rican Ambassador GONZALO FACIO] and advised that Dr. MIRO CARDONA had arrived in Washington, D. C., the previous evening and would like to get together with [FACIO]. [FACIO] was agreeable and said that "we" had been talking of getting together at 11:30 A. M., but noted that he had just received the call from Dr. LORA mentioned above. They both agreed that it seemed strange that LORA, who neither of them know, cancelled the appointment. [FACIO] said that he wanted very much to talk to MIRO because he, [FACIO] was scheduled to make a TV appearance on 9/25/62, in connection with the Cuban question. [ARAGON] and [FACIO] agreed to get together at 11:30 A. M. and was advised by ARAGON if a conflict developed he would notify [FACIO]. In addition, ARAGON advised [FACIO] that CARDONA normally stays at the Annapolis Hotel when in Washington, D. C. (S)

The informant later learned that [FACIO] had met with MIRO CARDONA and his associates and their meeting was described as very interesting by [FACIO]. (S)

[FACIO] during his contact with MIRO, indicated that he was in sympathy with MIRO and his associates but personally felt that open invasion of Cuba by American forces is the worse thing that could happen. (S)
