The memorandum dated 6/17/93 and captioned as above established policy with respect to informant/confidentiality postponements taken in FBI documents being processed pursuant to the John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (the Act). A copy of this memorandum is attached. One policy established was that informant symbol numbers would be released unless the combination of the release of highly singular information and the release of the symbol number could contribute to the identification of an informant. The likelihood of identification would occur most frequently where a particular symbol informant provided positive information on more than one occasion and by linking such reports of positive information attributed to the same symbol informant one might be able to identify the informant.
